At the invitation of the Rt. Hon. Mrs. Theresa May, Prime Minister of the United Kingdom, Prime Minister Right Honourable Mr. K P Sharma Oli arrived in London, today for a three-day official visit to the United Kingdom.

Upon arrival at the Heathrow International Airport of London, the Rt. Hon. Prime Minister was received by the British Minister of State for the Armed Forces, Rt. Hon. Mr. Mark Lancaster, Ambassador of Nepal to the United Kingdom, His Excellency Dr. Durga Bahadur Subedi and other officials at the Embassy of Nepal in London.

This evening, the Rt. Hon. Prime Minister, as a Guest of Honour, addressed the Special Ceremony organized by the Oxford Union at the University of Oxford and shared his thoughts on Nepal's successful peace process, democracy, development and on-going efforts to achieve prosperity. In his keynote speech, the Rt. Hon. Prime Minister highlighted the major priorities of the present Government and the long-term vision and mission of 'Prosperous Nepal, Happy Nepali'. More than 400 dignitaries comprising students, professors, researchers and academics attended the Ceremony. Following the Ceremony, the Rt. Hon. Prime Minister attended the dinner hosted by the Oxford Union in his honor.
