Prime Minister K P Sharma Oli addresses Nepali Community and Friends of Nepal in Geneva

Prime Minister, Rt. Hon. Mr. K P Sharma Oli, arrived in Geneva this afternoon leading a High-Level Nepali delegation to the Centenary International Labour Conference.

Upon arrival at Geneva International Airport, the Prime Minister was received by H. E. Mr. Mani Prasad Bhattarai, Ambassador/Permanent Representative of Nepal to the United Nations and other International Organizations, Ambassador/Permanent Representative of Switzerland to the United Nations and other International Organizations in Geneva, Councillor of Geneva Canton, Chief of Protocol Office of the Geneva International Airport and the officials of the Permanent Mission of Nepal in Geneva.

The Prime Minister attended a dinner reception hosted in his honour by H. E.
