The 2568th Buddha Jayanti was celebrated at the Embassy of Nepal in Beijing this morning. The program was attended by more than 120 participants including Ambassadors, diplomats, Chinese nationals from various organizations, members of the Nepali community living in China as well as representatives from media.
