Mr. Janga Bahadur Gurung, Deputy Chief of Mission/Counsellor of this Embassy, made an in-depth and comprehensive power-point presentation about Nepal, richness and diversities of Nepali cultural and religious heritages, the Himalayas and mountaineering, bio-diversities, and various kinds of opportunities of adventurous tourism and recreation activities that a tourist can visit and enjoy in Nepal. Mr. Gurung further elaborated about the system of visa, international and domestic transportation, accommodation etc. available to the visitors in Nepal.
