Deputy Prime Minister Calls on the Prime Minister of India

The Special Envoy of the Rt. Hon'ble Prime Minister, Mr. Pushpa Kamal Dahal 'Prachanda', Hon'ble Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Home Affairs Mr. Bimalendra Nidhi called on the Prime Minister of India, His Excellency Shri Narendra Modi in New Delhi this morning.
