At a brief courtesy meeting following the credentials presentation ceremony, President Temer recalled his recent meeting with the Prime Minister of Nepal during the BRICS-BIMSTEC Outreach Summit held in Goa.

The Nepali Ambassador highlighted the significance of such event for the regional cooperative initiative in the region.
